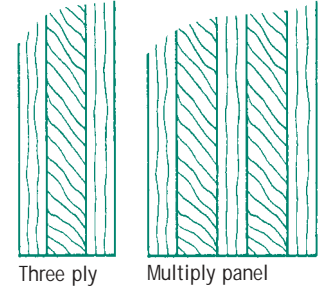
## Binder Practica three-ply and multiply panel

Face layers optically separated by machine guarantee that the panels will show no checks and will have an attractive, consistently even appearance. The ecologically beneficial multiply gluing process, combined with the strong covering,

mean that the raw material that is timber keeps all of its natural features and, additionally, is rendered more stable and more durable.
